Job purpose

The successful candidate will be provided with support in their professional development by the Phase Lead staff; Academy Goalkeeping Lead and Head of Coaching.

Main duties

- The successful candidate will work within our pre-academy and Foundation Phase structure (U7-U11), with occasional additional responsibilities across older age groups.
- Plan, deliver, and evaluate coaching sessions in line with the club's coaching blueprint.
- Deliver sessions in an engaging manner that embraces a culture of ongoing learning with appropriate levels of challenge and support.
- Matchday coaching will be a fundamental aspect of the role.
- Please note that candidates will be required to work during evenings and weekends.
- To follow and implement the Academy playing and coaching blueprint whilst contributing to its evolution.
- To ensure a thorough working knowledge of the content and functions of the Academy performance plan.
- Ensure thorough and up to date reporting of performance data via Football Intelligence Platform.
- To ensure player safeguarding is always the primary consideration in all players activities.
