The role

We are now looking to recruit to the role of Cleaner to assist in the preparation of all areas in and around the stadium to include Executive suites/Offices/Boxes and the Bowl of the stadium for match days and non-match days.

Role expectations

The successful applicant will be able to work effectively both in a team as well as on their own.

Reporting to the Cleaning Management Team, the cleaner will be expected:-

- To ensure all function suites, private executive boxes, offices, corridors, lifts, foyers and stadium bowl (Which includes stadium terracing/seating are cleaned to the required standard and all areas are free from debris.
- To ensure all carpeted areas are vacuumed and stains removed as required and any defects are reported to the Cleaning Management team.
- To ensure that the cleanliness of the toilets is maintained and laid down procedures for cleaning washrooms to a high standard are adhered to at all times and there are adequate toilet tissue and soap available at all times.
- To be pro-active and diligent in identifying and reporting maintenance/cleaning issues relating to equipment and rooms in use and report any outstanding issues to the Cleaning Management team.
- To carry out any specific cleaning requests.
- To deep clean areas using wet floor electrical cleaning equipment (full training will be provided) as requested by the Cleaning Management team.
- To follow all Health and Safety/COSHH responsibilities to include storage and handling of all chemicals.
- To maintaining high standards at all times.
- To be able to work flexible hours where the role requires.
- To comply with all Club policies.
